Consecrate Them...

In the discourse after the Last Supper, Christ prays for us, his Church. The master communicates to his disciples the paradoxical words they will have to live after his Ascension. They will be "in the world" but yet "not of the world". Christians are not to be tourists who pass through life without committing themselves to it. The gospel preaches no mystique of evasion. It commands Jesus' disciples to submit themselves to the law of his incarnation by taking on all that is human except sin and by refusing to ally themselves with evil and its kingdom of lies. They will also be the butt of "the world's hatred" and yet "filled with joy". For the sinful world cannot but oppose the subversion of a gospel which proclaims that the things of this world will pass away and that we must put our hearts where true joys lie. This is an uncomfortable attitude.- *Vienna International Religious Centre.*

We are **ambassadors for Jesus Christ**, "consecrated by means of truth" in order to transmit life as Christ does.

We are to be the visible presence of Jesus in the world. So, when people see me, they see Jesus! When people see me, they want to know Jesus! When people see me, they want to join our community, share our life, and take the Gospel as the foundation of their life! The positive and hopeful witness of the believer will overcome the negative and destructive influence of those forces that constantly attempt to destroy the harmony and goodness of God's creation.



THE SPIRITANS
(Congregation of the Holy Ghost, under the protection of the Immaculate Heart of Mary) were founded on Pentecost Sunday 1703 in Paris, France by a young man, Claude Poullart des Places (1679-1709). Claude was not yet an ordained priest but had a deep calling to found a community of young men who would be dedicated to the Holy Spirit and who would be willing to go to where they were called by the Church.


